A first-hand account of online personality Alex's life, struggles, and victories as a transgender teen, as well as a groundbreaking guide for transitioning teen.






A Quick & Easy Guide to They/Them Pronouns By Archie Bongiovanni








Birthday By Meredith Russo

Zenobia July By Lisa Bunker


An excellent coder and hacker investigates a mystery while wrestling with the challenges of a new school, a new family, and presenting her true gender for the first time.

Girl Mans Up By M-E Girard


